

## Recent 11+ Results Overview

The statistics below indicate the number of children who sat the Buckinghamshire Secondary Transfer 11+ Test in recent years and subsequently gained a place at one of the region's selective schools.

To provide some context on these figures, approximately 33% of children score 121 or more and at the end of the process and following Selection Reviews, approximately 37% qualify for grammar school.
