

Dear Parents,

All children in Years 3 to 6 have the opportunity of applying for instrumental/singing tuition which takes place during the school day on a weekly rota basis. Here is a list of tuition available:

- WOODWIND
Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Oboe
- BRASS
Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn, Cornet (Euphonium, Baritone, Tenor Horn available on request)
- STRINGS
Violin, Cello, Guitar, Ukulele
- SINGING
- DRUMS and PERCUSSION
- PIANO (a piano at home is a prerequisite)

When a pupil shows particular musical aptitude and interest it may be possible for them to take up a second instrument, as long as it is felt that withdrawal from another class lesson would not be detrimental to that particular child and upon consultation with teachers.

Lessons are half an hour in length and arranged on a weekly rotation so that the same class lesson is not missed regularly across the term. There is not a facility to be able to provide a fixed time each week. Lessons are charged at £20.00 per 30-minute lesson, termly in advance, payment being made directly to the visiting music teacher. In ALL cases, notice of six weeks of fees is required if a pupil wishes to discontinue lessons. A limited number of school instruments are available for hire (not including Guitar/ Ukulele) and I also have information about hire/purchase schemes from music shops.

In the event of all available places having been taken up then your child will be put on a waiting list until one becomes available, or an alternative may be selected. (Those already on a waiting list will take precedence.)

All requests will be dealt with on a first come, first served basis and after consultation with form teachers.

Please note that you do not need to re-apply for lessons if your child is already receiving them.
