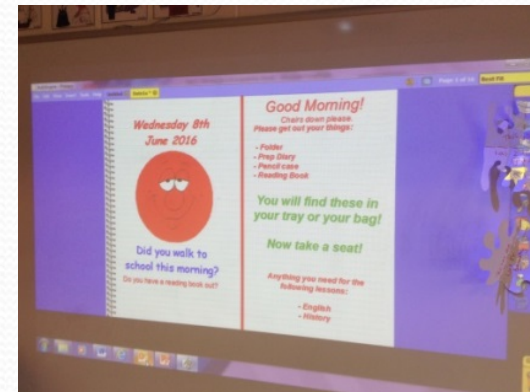

Outline of the Year 3 Day
