



Dear Parents,

Thank you for taking the time to look at our inaugural School Transport and Travel Guide for the 2021-2022 academic year. This is our first such guide, and the first time, as a school, that we have operated school minibuses routes.

We have produced this guide to provide an overview of the proposed school minibus network, and to provide further details, including timetable and fare information. Bookings for all routes can be made via the dedicated transport website at **gayhurst.vectare.co.uk**. This website allows you to enter your postcode, find your closest stop, and see bespoke travel information for your child’s journey to school.

The website allows for bookings to be made 24/7 from anywhere in the world, meaning that if you need to leave early for work one morning or you’re running late and you would like your child to travel on the school minibus service as a one off, you can make a booking. Late notice bookings are subject to availability, so we advise making a booking as early as possible.

For this year, we have decided to offer parents the option to book services from Ruislip or Hazlemere. On the Ruislip route, there are connections with London Underground and national railway lines. By doing this, you will be able to drop your child off, before catching a train to London.

We have tried to ensure that journey times, for all routes, remain as limited as possible. As such, some stops will be by request only. All other stops on the network will only be served if there is parental demand.

All routes will be operated by minibus drivers employed, and vetted, directly by Gayhurst, giving you peace of mind for your child’s safety. In addition, each route will also have a chaperone, who will also assist the children in boarding and alighting.

Additionally, we have partnered with Vectare, a specialist school transport management company. Through the website (**gayhurst.vectare.co.uk**), you will also be able to track your child’s journey to and from school, as well as being able to see when your child has boarded.

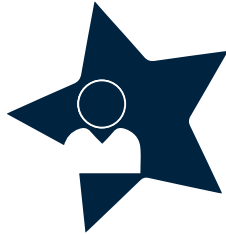

All of our routes are operated with Gayhurst School minibuses. We take pride in ensuring that all vehicle maintenance is of the highest standard, giving you peace of mind that your child is travelling to and from school in safety and comfort.



We use dedicated drivers and chaperones who work on the same route each day. These drivers get to know the pupils on their route and are subject to an enhanced disclosure and barring service check (DBS) and full MiDAS or CPC training.



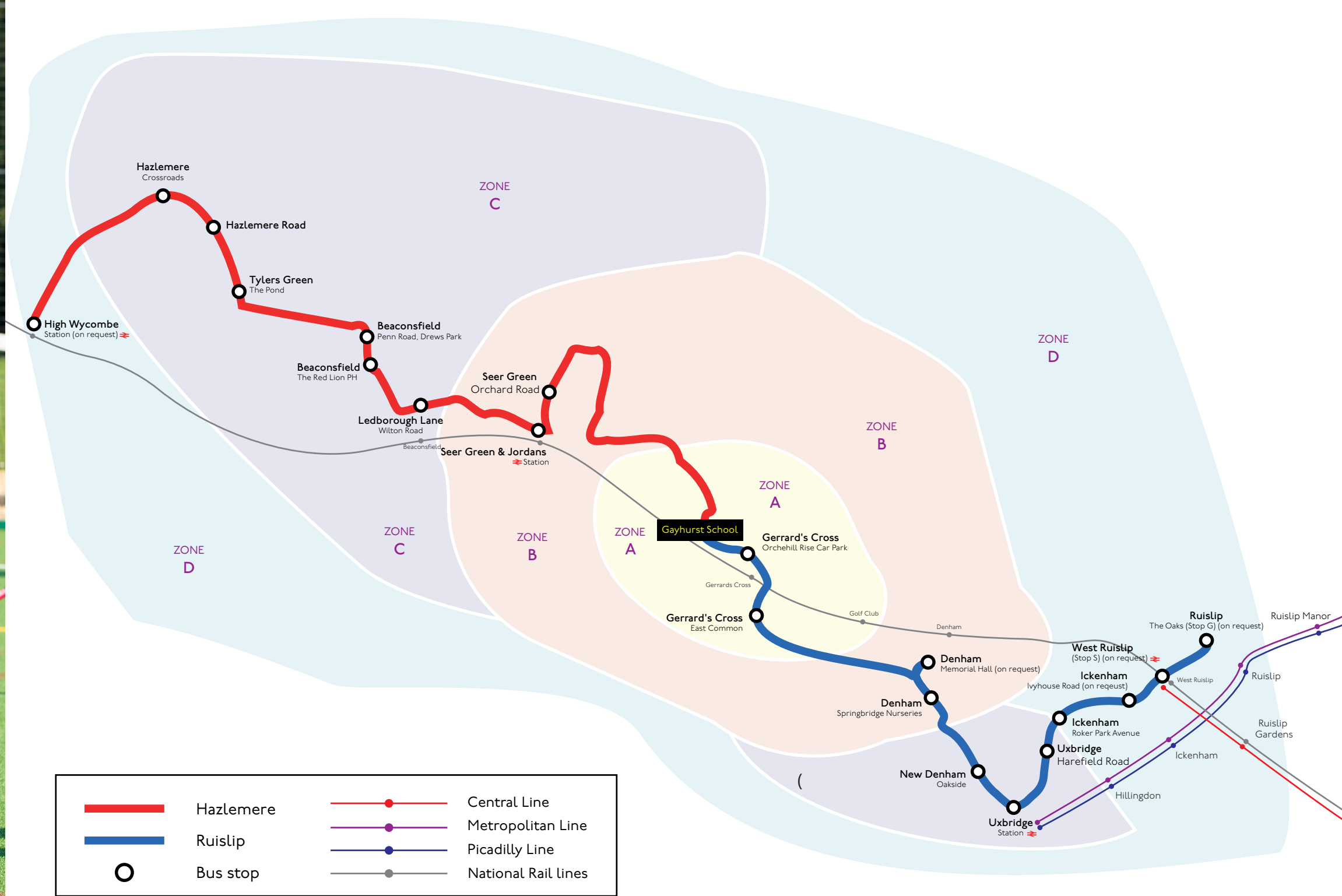
Bookings can be made at any time, via the online booking system. Termly passes are simply added to the school account. Subject to availability, bookings can also be made during the middle of each academic term, but we expect capacity to be limited.



Our network consists of 10+ minibus stops. We want to offer you a travel solution that works best for you and your child, so if you need any assistance working out the best minibus route to school, then please do get in touch.
